Please read the following books and create the book report format that follows each book.

Journey to the Alamo by Melodie Cuate

After reading this book you will create a Booklet Book Report.

Please follow the guidelines below.

1. Using a colored sheet of paper (construction paper, copy paper, etc) fold in half for the cover of your booklet. On the cover, write the title and author and an illustration representing what the book is about. Put your name on the back of the booklet.
2. Cut five pieces of lined notebook paper that will fit inside the book and fasten together.
3. Each sheet of paper will have a different topic to be addressed. Use your neatest handwriting and use complete sentences, making sure to include capital letters and punctuation. Each answer should be 4-5 sentences.

Setting: Time and place where the story takes place.

Three Main Characters: Describe who they are, what they were like and their part in the story.

Summarize the Plot: Using four to five sentences, tell about the major points of the story.

Problem: What is the major conflict in the story?

Resolution: How was the problem solved?

What would you change? Choose one thing in the story, either the setting, the characters, or the ending. Explain how your change would make a difference in the story.

Dear Mr. Henshaw by Beverly Cleary

After reading the book, you will draw a poster to advertise Dear Mr. Henshaw. Make it very detailed to show the setting, being sure to depict at least one character and one major event in the book. Be sure to include the title and author's name on the front and write your name on the back. You will have a test over the book the first week of school.
