1. Applications must be received by November 1, 2018.
2. You will be assigned an audition date and time upon when the primary wait list is exhausted and there are still openings.
3. Students prepare to audition by following the audition requirements posted as on our website (www.FWAFA.org/admission).
4. When called to audition, they are held on the FWAFA campus, located at 3901 S Hulen St, 76109.
5. Resumes, academic standings, and letters of recommendation are not considered for admission; only audition scores are considered for admission.
6. Acceptance for admission is contingent upon successful completion of the student's current grade level.
7. Students will not receive a copy of the completed rubric or score.
